

Coaches Code of Conduct

Applicable to all Coaches & Assistant Coaches of CJFC

Coaches & Assistant Coaches

- 1. Remember that junior football is about enjoyment of the game and player development
- 2. Maximise fun and put winning in perspective within a positive learning environment
- 3. Ensure that players understand what playing in a team means
- 4. Ensure the players are being taught the basic skills of the game
- 5. Develop team respect for opponents, umpires, coaches and team officials
- 6. Be prepared to lose at times for the development of the players
- 7. Give all players a reasonable amount of playing time and in a variety of positions
- 8. Keep up to date with coaching developments including coaching accreditation
- 9. Reject the use of performance enhancing substances in sport and abide by the guidelines set out in the AFL Drug Policy
- 10. Must have a current Working with Children Certification (WWCC), signed (current) YJFL Coaches Code of Conduct and AFL Level 1 and/or Foundation Coach accreditation
- 11. Must be registered with CoachAFL (https://coach.afl)
- 12. Maintain an Everproof account for the purpose of recording and managing their coaching qualifications
- 13. Be familiar with all CJFC Club Policies including, but not limited to, Principals & Values, Racial and Religious Tolerance, Equal Game Time, Team Composition and Complaints Policy
