

## **General Code of Conduct**

Applicable to all Parents, Players, Officials & Associates of CJFC

## General

- 1. Abide by the Laws of the Game, the Club's Rules & Yarra JFL's Rules
- 2. Respect and abide by the decisions of all umpires and officials
- 3. Verbal and physical abuse will not be tolerated
- 4. Do not vilify anyone on the basis of gender, race, religion or ethnic origin
- 5. Smoking and under-age drinking are prohibited
- 6. Recognise and support the voluntary contributions of all Club officials
- 7. Abide by all relevant CJFC Club Policies

## Parents

- 1. Encourage your children to participate for their own interest and enjoyment
- 2. Encourage children to always play for the team, and within the rules
- 3. Teach children that an honest effort is always as important as a victory
- 4. Acknowledge and applaud good play by both sides
- 5. Show appreciation and respect of all volunteers, officials and administrators
- 6. Support and foster the ethos of a community club by encouraging your children to build new friendships and community bonds outside of their school group
- 7. If you have an issue with a team official, ask for a meeting with the official, outside of match day. An official is not to be approached about an issue on match day
- 8. Any issues with the team should be discussed with the team officials, face to face and not amongst the broader parent group
- 9. The Club environment should not be used as a forum for the discussion of personal issues
- 10. All parents/adults must have a current Working with Children Check should they hold any of the following positions: Committee member, Team Manager, Coach, Assistant Coach, Trainer or Runner

## Players

- 1. Must understand and play by the rules of the game
- 2. Will be a team player and play the game in the right spirit (be a good sport)
- 3. Do not question or argue with umpires
- 4. Treat all teammates with respect (treat others as you would like to be treated)

- 5. Respect coaches and team officials and follow their instructions at training and on game day
- 6. Agree to attend training regularly
- 7. Treat opponents fairly and acknowledge them at the end of the game
- 8. Respect the Club's facilities and equipment at all times
